EPCOT Theme Park Project

Overview: You are a theme park designer for Disney World. You will be in charge of creating a new “Land” exhibit for Epcot. The three “Lands” that need to be developed are China, Korea (North and South), and Japan. As a designer, you will work on one of these lands and create the plan for the entire Land.

Due Date: You will present your theme park to the class on Wednesday, May 23.

Grading: You will receive a group grade for the content of your presentations (everyone will have the same group grade). You will also receive an individual grade for your part of the presentation, participation, on task behavior, and respectfulness. The group grade is worth 100 points, and the individual grade is worth 30 points.

Bonus Points: As a group, you may choose up to 3 bonus activities. Anyone in the group may work on the bonus activities. You are responsible for bringing in supplies for the bonus activities. You can earn up to 5 bonus points for each activity (for a total of up to 15 bonus points). The bonus points will be added to the group grade.

Assignments: In your group, decide who will be working on each part of the project. You can have up to two people working on each part of the project. You must all coordinate with one another so that your theme park works well together.

List who will be responsible for each part of the project. You may 1 or 2 people working on each part of the project. You will present the part of the project you were responsible for. **Each person in the group must present to the class at least once.**
